

Mercury Consolidation Timeline



PATH FORWARD

- All 14 warehouses at HWAD have been renovated to meet DNSC standards required to store the mercury
- All mercury equipment has been delivered to HWAD and tested for the receipt and storage of the elemental mercury
- All required mercury training has been completed
- CAPP registration form submitted to state in Jan '08
- Pre-Startup Safety Review (PSSR) to be formally initiated by HWAD in May '08
- Mercury will be transported in accordance with Department of Transportation guidelines and the DNSC Mercury Transportation and Storage Plan.

Drivers are all trained and certified hazardous material haulers

Mercury will be transported in closed tractor-trailers.

Shipments will be tracked via Global Positioning Satellite and drivers will have cellular telephones and CB radios

- Mercury test run of four trucks from DNSC depot to be conducted in early May '08
 - Ensure no safety concerns exist during shipments
 - Ensure acceptance/compliance procedures are met by truck transporter and HWAD
 - Ensure safe transfer and positioning of drums with mercury flasks from truck to warehouse
- Remainder of the mercury inventory shipments to commence end of May '08
