

- No Action – Includes agency decisions made on prior National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) analysis, i.e. 1996 SWEIS
- Expanded Operations - Increased levels of activity, new missions, or new facilities
- Reduced Operations – Discontinued programs, facilities or areas




# Existing NEPA documentation


- The Environmental Impact Statement for the Nevada Test Site and Off-Site Locations in the State of Nevada (DOE/NV 0243)

# Important SWEIS Dates

- July 24, 2009 – published Notice of Intent to prepare a SWEIS for the NTS and off-site locations in the state of Nevada
- September 10-18, 2009 – conducted four (4) public scoping meetings
- August 6, 2010 – complete distribution of Draft SWEIS to public
- August 6, 2010 – publish Notice of Availability in Federal Register
- August 6 - November 12, 2010 – public comment period
- September 27 - October 8, 2010 – conduct public hearings
