- ◆ **NAS Fallon land area = 8,670 acres**

◆ Churchill County population ~ 28,000

Environmental



- ◆ **No notices of violation (NOVs) since 2001**
- ◆ **29 Installation Remediation sites on base**
 - 19 closed, 2 pending closure, 8 active
 - FY09 budget = \$2.3M
 - Funding for FY10-15 = \$5.5M
- ◆ **Declared ISO 14001 EMS compliant – 18 MAR 09**
 - First NRSW installation to achieve this distinction



Operational Sustainability



- ◆ **Coordinate joint land-use planning with Churchill County for the Joint Land Use Study.**
- ◆ **Maintain sustainable renewable resource studies to identify potential areas of renewable resources.**
 - ◆ **USGS Water study of the Dixie Valley surface water recharge**
 - ◆ **NGPO Geothermal study of Dixie Valley and B-19 potential resources**
- ◆ **Installation surface water utilization plan**
 - ◆ **1058 total acres in the APZ where live ordnance jettison impacts are most likely and aircraft crashes occur historically**
