# MCMWTC MOA

- Proposed Special Use Airspace as the Walker Low/High MOA in support of Mountain Training Exercises and DoD unit level Mountain Warfare training conducted at MWTC Bridgeport, California
- SUA establishment determined to be essential to safely and effectively support MCMWTC's training program in its Class G and E airspace
- Developed in conjunction with the FAA: Oakland Center and Western Service Area



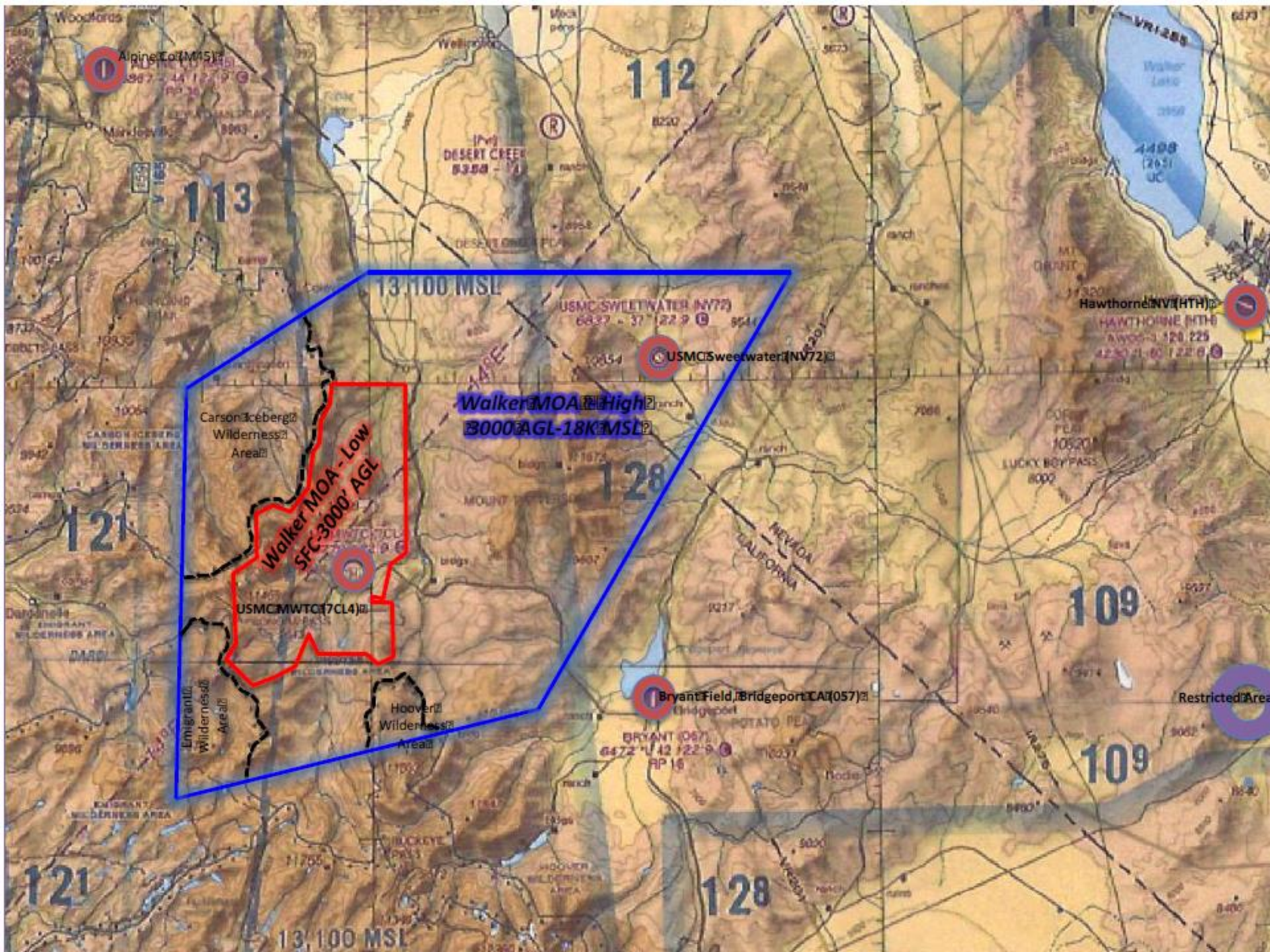
# MCMWTC MOA

- Joint Use
- Supports Rotary and Fixed Wing Aviation during day and night operations
- Identifies the location of high density nonhazardous military flight activities and training to non-participants
- Heighten awareness of VFR aviators, and separate IFR traffic, operating near or within the MOA



# MCMWTC MOA

- Walker MOA Low: Surface up to but not including 3,000' AGL
- Walker MOA High: 3,000' AGL up to but not including FL180
- Notice To Airman (NOTAM) at least 4 hours prior to activation
- MTX occurs, on average, 8 times per year
  - Up to 100 days/year
  - At least 15 hours/day when active
