Economic Highlights



NAS Fallon contribution to the regional economy of Churchill, Lyon, and Washoe counties for federal fiscal year 2015 -

- Total economic contribution \$517 million
- Direct payroll \$84 million
- Employment 4,586 jobs
- ➤ Taxes \$22 million
- Federal Impact Aid \$608k
- > REPI \$2.44 million






Main Components of EIA



Components of the NAS Fallon Economic Impact Analysis

- Total industry output
- Labor income
- Employment (jobs)
- Taxes





Foundation of the Report



- Science based/rule based modeling modeling software IMPLAN
- Transparent investigation and repeatable methodology – total industry output, labor income, employment, taxes
- Detailed data derived directly from source data supporting local spending, employment figures, and face to face interviews with NAS Fallon commands



Funding - Economic Analysis



Types of economic funding used for the economic analysis

- Direct- funding directly created or spent by the base
- Indirect- changes in sales, income or jobs in sectors within the region that supply goods and services to the base (other business to business transactions)
- Induced- increased sales within the region from household spending of the income from the base including
