This project covers the construction of a grease receiving station and cogenerating power unit at the Minden-Gardnerville Sanitation District WWTP in Minden. This green energy project will allow the facility to produce its own electricity to meets its power needs at the plant. Grease from area restaurants will be delivered to a processing station as a fuel source to the plants existing anaerobic sludge digesters. The gas generated from this biological decomposition process will be used to generate electricity with a new natural gas powered digester. This project will reduce the quantity of grease that is presently being wasted at area landfills and provides a green energy fuel source.

This project is being funded by the federal funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009.

There are no specific activities to construct this proposed project that would constitute an environmental disturbance outside of the existing footprint of the wastewater treatment facility. Therefore, the Division's environmental review process did not indicate significant environmental impacts from this project construction. Therefore, a determination for a Categorical Exclusion is being publically noticed for 30 days.
