Subject: Yerington Paiute Tribe- Construction of a Distribution Line, Upsize the Arsenic Water Treatment Facility adding Solar Paneling, and Repaint Existing Water Storage Tank

Dear Coordinator:

Pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between our agencies, this is to notify you that the USDA - Rural Development has received an application for a loan/grant from the Yerington Paiute Tribe. The proposed project includes new construction of 5900 LF 8" water pipeline to serve Rite of Passage, juvenile detention facility, and 5,554 LF of 6" water line to eight (8) assignees on Campbell loop to the Tribes existing water system. In addition, the Tribe proposes to install solar paneling and up size the existing arsenic water treatment facility to provide a more efficient source of power & water quality and finally, to recoat their water storage tank inside and out to meet EPA compliance. The majority of the construction will take place in existing rights of way and in previously disturbed areas located within the boundaries of the Yerington Paiute Reservation located on Campbell Ranch Road with a portion of the proposed 8" water line to the Rights of Passage facility requiring easements from the Bureau of Land Management.

Attached is map and photos showing the location of the proposed project.

Unless the Clearinghouse Coordinator advises us otherwise, within 30 days of this notice, we will assume that the final Clearinghouse comments will not be forthcoming and, therefore, the State Clearinghouse responsibilities of USDA - Rural Development will have been satisfied.

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



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
