



**TRANSPORTATION NOTICE
PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING
SR 160 Improvements Project: SR 159 to Mountain Springs**

PURPOSE OF MEETING: The Nevada Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration, is conducting a public information meeting to provide information and receive comments on proposed improvements to State Route 160 from State Route 159 to just west of Mountain Springs, Clark County, Nevada.

In compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, NDOT is initiating an assessment of the proposed project's potential environmental impacts. This notice is to inform the public of the study and to solicit comments concerning the project.

The proposed improvements to SR 160 would consist of realigning and widening the roadway to four travel lanes (two in each direction) from SR 159 to 1.24 miles west of Mountain Springs Summit in order to provide a safe and efficient east-west facility accommodating vehicles, bicyclists and pedestrians.

WHEN AND WHERE: Thursday, May 13, 2010, 4 p.m. – 7p.m. at Reedom Elementary School, 10025 Rumrill St., Multi-Purpose Room Las Vegas, NV.

WHY: The purpose of the project is to improve operational efficiency and safety in response to existing and proposed development. SR 160 serves the Las Vegas Valley as the primary transportation link between Pahrump and southwest Las Vegas, downtown Las Vegas and Interstate 15. Several segments on SR 160 between I-15 and Pahrump have recently been widened or are currently under design for widening.

WHERE YOU COME IN: You are invited to attend the public meeting between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. There will be a brief project presentation at 5:30 p.m. followed by a short comment period. Before and after the presentation at 5:30 p.m., the meeting will be conducted in an "open house" format to provide you with an opportunity to view the displays and individually discuss the project with project representatives.

Your comments may be submitted for the public record in writing at the meeting or verbally to a court reporter who will be available throughout the meeting. In addition to any comments received at the meeting, written or email comments will be accepted through 5 p.m., Friday May 28, 2010.
