Geyser Petroleum, Inc has submitted a Application for Permit to Drill (APD) to the Egan Field Office for the intent of drilling a 6,000-foot wildcat oil and gas well in Railroad Valley, approximately 7 ½ miles southwest of Currant, Nevada. Access would be from Highway 6 on four miles of existing unpaved road and approximately 960 feet of newly constructed road. Total project surface disturbance would be less than five acres. A nearby artesian well would serve as the water source for drilling operations. The operator anticipates operations to commence in the summer of 2010.


