As required by NAC 445.42116 through NAC 445.42128, an environmental review has been performed on the proposed project listed below:

Project: Clark County Water Reclamation District
Membrane Filtration and Ozonation System

Location: Clark County Water Reclamation Facility
Clark County, Nevada

Latitude 36° 06' 48" W
Longitude 115° 01' 32" W

Project Numbers: CS32-1018

This project covers the construction of a 30 million gallon per day advanced treatment system at the Clark County Water Reclamation District's main plant. This treatment system will be constructed within the site of the old AWT facility of the main plant. The advanced treatment system will consist of membrane filtration and ozonation. This treatment system will process 30 million gallons per day of secondary treated effluent from the main plant for discharge to reuse sites and surface discharge to the Las Vegas Wash. This project will provide an environmental benefit by greatly improving the effluent quality that is already being discharged to reuse sites and to the Las Vegas Wash from the main plant. Additionally, this project expands the reuse options for the effluent, saving water resources for the County.

Since this project will occur entirely within the boundaries of the existing AWT facility (i.e., not on undisturbed land), the Division is issuing a preliminary Categorical Exclusion environmental determination for this project. Information supporting this decision is available for public review at the office of the Division listed above.

After evaluating all comments received, the Division will make a final decision on whether to issue this Categorical Exclusion ruling.
