Subject: Lovelock Meadows Water District Phase III Project

Dear Coordinator:

Pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between our agencies, this is to notify you that the USDA - Rural Development has received a request for financial assistance from Lovelock Meadows Water District, located in Pershing County, Nevada. The owner proposes to add improvements to their water systems as follows:

- 1) To the South of Lovelock replace 12,550 linear feet of existing 2" waterline with new 8" waterline, install 6,540 linear feet of 8" waterline on Lower Valley Rd and Westfall Road to loop the existing water system, install new pressure reducing valves on Lower Valley Road and South Meridian Road, and install new flushing valves on dead end lines at Peterson Road, Lake Road, Westfall Road, Carpenter Road, South Meridian Road, and Westergard Road.
- 2) To the Northwest of Lovelock Replace 8,300 linear feet of waterline with new 8" waterline, replace 3,530 feet of 3" waterline with new 8" waterline, install 6,580 feet of new 8" waterline on Lone Mountain Road to loop the water system, and Install a new Pressure Reducing Valve at the intersection of Pitt Road and Lone Mountain Road.
- 3) Approximately 4.5 miles northeast of Lovelock install a new waterline down Coal Canyon Road, install a new waterline along Upper Valley Road from Coal Canyon Road to Marker Lane, install a new waterline along Marker Lane to serve existing homes along Marker Lane and replace old 2" waterline.


At Lower Valley Road North End Looking NE toward Lovelock Pipeline to be located along edge of roadway




On Lower Valley Road Same Location as above looking SW Pipeline to be located along edge of roadway














































MARKER LANE PIPELINE
