



**TRANSPORTATION NOTICE
PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING FOR**

**Cactus Avenue/I-15 Interchange Project and
I-15 Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) Installation
Stateline to I-15/I-215 Interchange**

WHAT: The Nevada Department of Transportation will hold a public information meeting to provide an update and to gather public comments on traffic improvements for the proposed I-15 Interchange at Cactus Avenue in Clark County. Proposed improvements include the construction of an interchange providing access in all directions between I-15 and Cactus Avenue, the construction of Cactus Avenue between Dean Martin Drive and Las Vegas Boulevard, improvements to Cactus Avenue between Polaris Road and Dean Martin Drive, installation of traffic signals, signing and striping, improvements to drainage and flood control facilities and landscaping and aesthetics.

Also, NDOT is working to improve the I-15 corridor from the Nevada-California border to the I-15/I-215 interchange. The project's purpose is to improve traffic operations on I-15 with the design and construction of Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) improvements. Intelligent Transportation Systems utilize communications technology (such as overhead dynamic message boards, ramp meters and closed circuit television cameras) to improve traffic operations and incident management. This system is proposed to be designed and installed along I-15, from state line to I-215 in both directions.

Please join us for updates on these important transportation projects.

Starr Interchange and I-15 South Design-Build information also will be provided. Project representatives and materials for each of these projects will be available.

WHEN AND WHERE: Thursday, Aug. 12, 2010, 4 p.m. – 7 p.m. at Southern Highlands Preparatory School, gymnasium, 11500 Southern Highlands Pkwy, Las Vegas, NV.

WHY: The purpose of the proposed improvements is to alleviate existing and projected congestion, serve proposed growth in the corridor by improving local circulation and access, and accommodate regional and local transportation demand.

WHERE YOU COME IN: You are invited to attend the public information meeting between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. There will be brief presentations on both projects at 5:30 p.m., followed by a short comment period. Before and after the presentations at 5:30 p.m., the meeting will be conducted in an "open house" format to provide you with an opportunity to view the displays and individually discuss the project with the project representatives. If you are unable to attend the meeting, information can be obtained through the contact below.

Your comments may be submitted for the public record in writing at the meeting or verbally to a court reporter who will be available throughout the meeting. In addition to any comments received at the meeting, written or e-mail comments will be accepted through 5 p.m. Friday, August 27, 2010. Please e-mail your comments to info@dot.state.nv.us with a reference to either project in the subject line. You may mail your comments to the contacts below.

IF RIGHT-OF-WAY IS NEEDED: The Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 will govern the acquisition of right-of-way that may be necessary for the Cactus interchange project. The improvements associated with the ITS project are not expected to require the acquisition of any private property (right-of-way), and minimal traffic impacts are anticipated.
