



TRANSPORTATION NOTICE PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

US 50 Moundhouse Improvements Project

PURPOSE OF MEETING: The Nevada Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration, is conducting a public information meeting to provide information and receive comments on proposed improvements to US Highway 50 from 0.20 mile east of Deer Run Road in Carson City to one mile east of State Route 341 in Moundhouse, Lyon County, Nevada.

In compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, NDOT is initiating an assessment of the proposed project's potential environmental impacts. This notice is to inform the public of the study and to solicit comments concerning the project.

In order to provide a safe and efficient transportation facility accommodating vehicles, bicyclists and pedestrians, NDOT is proposing improvements that may include widening the existing roadway to accommodate a continuous raised median island with "T" intersections at certain locations, a new interchange to be located between Hillside Drive and Affonso Drive, construction of new frontage/backage roads to facilitate the flow of local traffic within the Moundhouse area, making improvements to existing local and connecting roads, and installation of street lighting.

WHEN AND WHERE: Thursday, October 21, 2010, 4 p.m. – 7p.m. at the Lyon County Utilities Building, 34 Lakes Blvd. #103, Dayton, NV.

WHY: The purpose of the project is to improve safety on US 50 through Moundhouse and to create a transportation facility that can accommodate increased traffic capacity brought about by past development and planned future development.

WHERE YOU COME IN: You are invited to attend the public meeting between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. There will be a brief project presentation at 5:30 p.m. followed by a short comment period. Before and after the presentation at 5:30 p.m., the meeting will be conducted in an "open house" format to provide you with an opportunity to view the displays and individually discuss the project with project representatives.

Your comments may be submitted for the public record in writing at the meeting or verbally to a court reporter who will be available throughout the meeting. In addition to any comments received at the meeting, written or email comments will be accepted through 5 p.m., Friday November 5, 2010. Please email your comments to info@dot.state.nv.us with a reference to this project in the subject line. You may mail your comments to Steve M. 


