



TRANSPORTATION NOTICE PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

Boulder City Bypass Phase 1

PURPOSE OF MEETING: The Nevada Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration, is conducting a public information meeting to discuss proposed design modifications to Phase 1 of the Boulder City Bypass freeway project. Phase 1 of the project, from Foothills Drive to the interchange with US 95, will improve operations and safety near Railroad Pass and extend the freeway to US 95. The proposed design modifications would include deleting a frontage road along the east side of the freeway between the Railroad Pass Casino and Foothills Drive and connecting the west frontage through to Dawson Avenue in Henderson.

WHEN AND WHERE: Tuesday, Oct. 26, 2010, 4 p.m. – 7 p.m. at Mannion Middle School, 155 E. Paradise Hills Dr., Henderson, NV 89002.

WHY: The proposed design change would more efficiently improve local traffic movement and safety in the project after-condition and perpetuate the railroad crossing for the Nevada State Railroad Museum. Due to local development and the need for access to adjacent land uses, the construction of a west frontage road through to Dawson Avenue would facilitate and improve local traffic circulation between southeast Henderson and northwest Eldorado Valley.

WHERE YOU COME IN: You are invited to attend the public meeting between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. There will be a brief project presentation at 5:30 p.m. followed by a short comment period. Before and after the presentation at 5:30 p.m., the meeting will be conducted in an "open house" format to provide you with an opportunity to view the displays and individually discuss the project with project representatives.

Your comments may be submitted for the public record in writing at the meeting or verbally to a court reporter who will be available throughout the meeting. In addition to any comments received at the meeting, written or email comments will be accepted through 5 p.m., Friday, Nov. 12, 2010.
