Dear Interested Party:

Midway Gold Corporation (MGC) Resources Inc. is proposing to continue exploring the Pan Project area for gold using reverse circulation and core drilling techniques. The project area is located in west White Pine County in the Pancake Range approximately 5 miles south of Highway 50. MGC is currently authorized to disturb 25 acres. In addition to drill road and pad construction, MGC is also proposing to excavate exploration trenches, develop a new access road into the site, construct nine groundwater monitoring wells, and add other exploration related facilities. This proposed amendment will increase ground disturbance from 25 to 100 acres in White Pine County, Nevada (see attached map).
