

**TRANSPORTATION NOTICE  
PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING  
Storm Water Management Plan**

**Purpose of the Meeting**

The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) invites all interested persons to review and comment on the proposed NDOT **Draft** Storm Water Management Plan (SWMP).

NDOT has been issued a Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) Permit by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection, authorizing the discharge of municipal stormwater runoff to waters of the United States. NDOT is required to develop and implement a Stormwater Management Program (SWMP) that will address the requirements of the permit. The ultimate goal of the SWMP is to reduce the discharge of pollutants from NDOT's MS4 areas to the maximum extent practicable to protect water quality, and to satisfy the appropriate water quality requirements of the Clean Water Act. NDOT is holding this public meeting pursuant to the requirements of the permit in accordance with the Nevada open meeting law.
