PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) will host a public information meeting to receive input on the safety recommendations proposed for Kietzke Lane, from Galletti Way to South Virginia Street. NDOT conducted a study that examined the safety issues and concerns on Kietzke Lane in order to make recommendations for improvements on this road to enhance safety for all road users. The proposed safety recommendations may directly affect you. They include:

- *Bicycle safety improvements that may include the removal of on-street parking*
- *Pedestrian safety improvements including sidewalks, lighting and pedestrian crossings*
- *Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) improvements that may include sidewalk widening into parking areas*
- *Intersection safety improvements that may include raised medians and roundabouts*
