



**TRANSPORTATION NOTICE
PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING FOR
U.S. 95 Northwest Corridor Improvements Project
Phase 2A**



PURPOSE OF MEETING: The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT), in partnership with the City of Las Vegas and in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), invites you to a public information meeting for construction information on Phase 2A of the U.S. 95 Northwest Corridor Improvements Project. This freeway project addresses the short- and long-term transportation needs for a portion of the U.S. 95 corridor from Ann Road to Durango Drive, which is scheduled for construction starting in 2014. Improvements include widening U.S. 95 to three general purpose lanes and one HOV lane and auxiliary lanes in each direction. The project will also include construction of landscape and aesthetic enhancements, as well as sound walls in noise sensitive areas.

In addition, representatives will also be in attendance to provide information on related projects in the area.

WHEN AND WHERE: **Wednesday, July 24, 2013, from 4 – 7 p.m.** at the Centennial Hills Active Adult Center Multipurpose Room, 6601 N. Buffalo Drive, Las Vegas, NV.

PROJECT BENEFITS: The purpose is to alleviate congestion within the corridor by increasing capacity and to improve regional connectivity, consistent with land use planning, by providing improved freeway connections.

WHERE YOU COME IN: You are invited to attend the public information meeting between 4 – 7 p.m. There will be a brief project presentation at 5:30 p.m., followed by a short open comment period. Before and after the presentation at 5:30 p.m., the meeting will be conducted as an open house to provide you with an opportunity to view the displays and individually discuss the project with project representatives.

Your comments may be submitted for the public record in writing at the meeting or verbally to a court reporter, who will be available throughout the meeting. In addition to any comments received at the meeting, written or email comments will be accepted through **5 p.m. Friday, August 9, 2013**.
