

BLM Seeks Public Comment to Lease Public Land for a High School in Sandy Valley

LAS VEGAS – The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Las Vegas Field Office is seeking public comment on a proposal to lease and or subsequently convey approximately 30 acres of public land to the Clark County School District for a high school in Sandy Valley, Nev.

The parcel is located at E. Placer Drive and N. Hopi Street. Sandy Valley students must travel 40 miles to attend Liberty High School in Henderson. The proposed high school would be located next to existing elementary and middle schools. Public comments will be accepted for 45 days until Monday, **August 19**.

BLM Seeks Public Comment to Lease Land to the City of Las Vegas for Fire Station

LAS VEGAS – The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Las Vegas Field Office is seeking public comment on a proposal to lease and/or subsequently convey approximately 2.5 acres of public land to the City of Las Vegas, to build a fire station in northwest Las Vegas south of Kyle Canyon Road and east of Puli Drive. The fire station would consist of a three-bay fire engine garage, kitchen facilities, living quarters, off-site improvements (curb, gutter, sidewalk and street lights), landscaping and parking lot. Public comments will be accepted for 45 days until Monday, **August 19**.

BLM Seeks Public Comment to Lease Land to Las Vegas for a Public Park

LAS VEGAS – The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Las Vegas Field Office is seeking public comment on a proposal to lease and/or subsequently convey approximately 12.5 acres of public land to the City of Las Vegas to build a public park located in the northwest area of Las Vegas, south of Kyle Canyon Road and west of Puli Drive. The park would consist of group and single table picnic shelters, dog park, child splash pad play area, shaded child play area, meandering interpretive walking paths and trails, parking area, restrooms, and open space, as well as off-site improvements such as curb, gutter, sidewalk, and street lighting. Public comments will be accepted for a period of 45 days until Monday, **August 19**.
