### **NOTICE OF WORKSHOP TO SOLICIT PUBLIC COMMENT ON PROPOSED NEW REGULATIONS REGARDING THE USE OF STATE LAND BENEATH NAVIGABLE WATERS**

### **AND CONCURRENT REPEAL OF SECTIONS 445A.028 to 445A.052 OF THE NEVADA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE**

The Nevada Division of State Lands (NDSL) is proposing new regulation language authorizing structures to occupy state land associated with all navigable waters. The new regulations address the use of state land under the Carson River, Colorado River, Lake Tahoe, Truckee River, Virgin River, Walker Lake, Washoe Lake and Winnemucca Lake. NDSL is also proposing to repeal sections 445A.028 to 445A.052 of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) that authorizes the construction of piers, breakwaters and mooring buoys at Lake Tahoe. Currently this section only addresses construction projects and not the long term occupancy and use of land associated with all state navigable waters.

The proposed language is primarily an administrative clean up that will better align the permitting process and procedure with NDSL statutory authority. Some of the desired outcomes of this process are to more clearly define required location standards, clarify the application review process and eliminate duplicate definitions currently found in NRS 322.
