16 **I. INTRODUCTION**

17 SVS intends to construct, own, and operate the Sunshine Valley Solar Project (the
18 "Project") in the Town of Amargosa Valley, Nevada, which is in an unincorporated portion of
19 Nye County, approximately thirty miles northwest of Pahrump. The Project will consist of an
20 approximately 110-megawatt AC photovoltaic electric generating facility and associated
21 facilities, described in more detail below. The Project will interconnect at Valley Electric
22 Association's (VEA) 138 kV Valley Substation, via an approximately 0.5 mile generation-tie
23 (gen-tie) transmission line.

24 The electric generating facility and gen-tie route are located entirely on non-federal lands;
25 therefore, no environmental analysis is required by a federal agency. Accordingly, this
26 application is filed pursuant to the requirements of NRS 704.870(1) and NAC 703.423.

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
