Aesthetic Themes for the I-580 Corridor Interchanges  
Near the Summit Mall to Neil Road in Washoe County**

**PURPOSE OF MEETING:** The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) invites you to a public information meeting for the I-580 Landscape and Aesthetic Plans, in Washoe County. There are five interchanges along I-580 for which landscape and aesthetic preliminary designs are being prepared. These include Neil Road (aesthetics only), South Virginia Street/Patriot Boulevard, South Meadows Parkway, Damonte Ranch Parkway and the South Virginia Street interchange near the Summit Mall.

Elements to be addressed include improving the relationship between the highway and the community, increasing tourism opportunities and enhancing the attractiveness of the interchange. Working together, NDOT and local communities can identify opportunities for partnerships and enhancements that will result in improved highway corridors that enhance the quality of life of Nevada's citizens as well as tourism and travel within the state.

NDOT and Stantec Consulting have been working on a design to address the landscape and aesthetics of these interchanges based on NDOT's previously approved US 395 (I-580) Landscape and Aesthetics Corridor Plan. During the planning process, the design team assessed the existing conditions along the interchanges and developed preliminary design ideas for improving the appearance of the NDOT right-of-way at these locations. The Truckee Meadows Ranching History has been developed as the landscape and aesthetics theme.

**HOW TO PARTICIPATE:** You are invited to attend the public information meeting between 4–7 p.m. There will be a brief **presentation at 5:30 p.m.** followed by a short comment period from the audience. The meeting will be conducted as an open house to provide you with an opportunity to view displays and have your individual questions answered by project representatives.

Your comments on the I-580 Landscape and Aesthetics Plans may be submitted for the public record at the meeting either in writing on a comment sheet or verbally to a court reporter, who will be available throughout the meeting. Written or email comments will also be accepted through **5 p.m., Tuesday, July 1, 2014**.
