## **BLM Seeks Input on the Yerington Water Tank, Utility Line, and Road Right-of-Way**

Carson City, Nev. – The Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Sierra Front Office is seeking public comments on a right-of-way application from the City of Yerington, Nevada to construct and maintain a water facility and access road to provide Sunset Hill residents with safe drinking water. The project is located on 2.4 acres of public land northwest of Yerington, near Luzier Lane. Public comments on the Draft environmental assessment (EA) will be accepted from November 10 through November 24.

This Draft EA analyzes the potential impacts from the proposed development. The proposed activities include:

- Installation and maintenance of a 500,000 gallon water storage tank;
- Installation and maintenance of a 1,200 feet of buried water pipe along Luzier Lane;
- Use of a .6 acre area to temporarily store pipe during construction; and
- Use and maintenance of a 1,200-foot access road within Luzier Lane.
