North Las Vegas Boulevard Improvements Project  
Carey Avenue to Craig Road



The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) will host a public information meeting to receive input on the operational and safety recommendations proposed for North Las Vegas Boulevard (State Route 604), from Carey Avenue to Craig Road. NDOT conducted a study in 2010 that examined the safety issues and concerns on Las Vegas Boulevard in order to make recommendations for improvements on this road to enhance safety for all road users. In addition, the NDOT recommends improving the bus lanes to enhance durability of the roadway surface. The proposed recommendations may directly affect you. They include:

- Intersection safety improvements that include raised median islands
- Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) improvements that include sidewalk widening around bus stop areas and improved driveways. Some landscape areas may be affected.
- Pedestrian safety improvements including new sidewalks, lighting and pedestrian crossings
- Bus lane improvements to include improved access to and around shelters
