



**TRANSPORTATION NOTICE
PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING
I-15 at Tropicana Avenue Interchange Feasibility Study**

PURPOSE OF MEETING: The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), invites you to attend a public information meeting to solicit input for the I-15 at Tropicana Avenue Interchange Feasibility Study, in Las Vegas. The study is considering the overall operations of the I-15 and Tropicana interchange, including I-15 operations from Hacienda to Harmon and Tropicana operations from Valley View to Las Vegas Boulevards.

PROJECT BENEFITS: Congestion within the I-15 corridor, along Tropicana Avenue and at the ramp exits and entrances creates delays for all users. The existing Tropicana overpass bridge has insufficient clearance over I-15 and does not have sufficient width underneath to allow for any future I-15 widening in either the northbound or southbound directions. As traffic demands increase, the congestion will only worsen resulting in increased delays.

The purpose of the study is to determine a range of improvements that could alleviate the congestion on both I-15 and in the vicinity of the interchange on Tropicana Avenue, and to recommend the most feasible solution.

There will be a brief project presentation at 5:30 p.m. followed by a short comment period from the audience. Before and after the presentation, the meeting will be conducted as an open house format to provide attendees with an opportunity to view displays and individually discuss the project with project representatives. Your comments may be submitted for public record in writing at the meeting or verbally to a court reporter, who will be available throughout the meeting. In addition to any comments received at the meeting, written or email comments will be accepted through Friday, October 16, 2015.
