CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION CLEAN WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN

The Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) in Sections NAC 445A.742 to 445A.762, inclusive, outlines the environmental review procedures to be followed by the Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) to meet the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act. This project will utilize funds from the Clean Water State Revolving Loan Fund.

Project Name: Railroad St Sewer Main Rehabilitation/Replacement

Project No.: 3 - Year 2017 Clean Water Priority List

Applicant: Lyon County

Clean Water State Revolving Fund Assistance: \$500,000

Lyon County Utilities has identified the need to replace 1,100 feet of failing gravity sewer main along Railroad St in Dayton. This section of sewer main is in such a deteriorated state that the County is no longer able to clean and maintain the pipeline due to the risk of significant pipe failure. In addition, an internal video of the pipeline near the south end of Railroad St where it meets Louie Way and continues east under the Carson River showed that there is one point of infiltration that is flowing about 2 gpm into the sewer pipe and will require a spot repair.

NDEP assessed the potential environmental effects of the proposed project and determined that the project is eligible for a categorical exclusion under NAC 445A.67583 because it involves rehabilitation/replacement of existing system equipment and is unlikely to have a negative effect on the quality of the environment and an environmental impact statement is not required. No national landmarks or property with nationally significant historic, architectural, prehistoric, archeological, or cultural value will be adversely affected by the project. No wetlands, floodplains, or agricultural lands are affected by the project. One federally threatened species was identified by the US Fish and Wildlife Service; however, this project will be timed to be completed outside of the breeding season and there will be no permanent loss of habitat due to the project.

Consultation with appropriate cross-cutting agencies will be completed prior to signing a final commitment of financial assistance. Best management practices will be utilized during construction. Documentation supporting these conclusions is available for public examination at the office of the Division of Environmental Protection, 901 S. Stewart St., Suite 4001, Carson City, Nevada.




