RE: Mesquite Airport Master Plan

To Whom It May Concern,

GDA Engineers is currently completing an Airport Master Plan for Mesquite Airport (K67L) located in Mesquite, Nevada. This Master Plan will be reviewed by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and Nevada Department of Transportation Aviation Planning Section.

The Airport Master Plan includes an overview of environmentally sensitive topics at the airport. This is intended to help the airport owner and funding agencies judge if the potential projects might affect the environment in a positive, neutral, or negative way.

The enclosed drawing depicts the current airport and potential future development that has been identified as needed. Over the next 20 years, Mesquite Airport has three potential large development projects. The first would pave the area between the existing apron and northern taxiway, creating a new apron area for hangars and tie-downs. The next project would create a smaller apron area on the north side of the airport for the medical evacuation helicopters and additional hangar space. The final project, which is an extremely long-term proposal, would extend the runway to the northeast by 755'. All proposed development projects would meet FAA design standards.

Following the NEPA process, the FAA has created a summary of requirements and procedures to be used in environmental impact analyses. These requirements and procedures are divided into Requirements, FAA Responsibilities, Significant Impact Threshold, and Analysis of Significant Impacts.

The following impact categories will be reviewed:

- Air Quality
- Coastal Resources
- Compatible Land Use
- Construction Impacts
- Department of Transportation Act; Section 4(f); Farmlands
- Fish, Wildlife, and Plants
- Floodplains
- Hazardous Materials, Pollution Prevention, and Solid Waste
- Historical, Architectural, Archaeological and Cultural Resources
- Light Emissions and Visual Impacts
- Natural Resources and Energy Supply
- Noise
- Secondary (Induced) Impacts
- Socioeconomic Impacts, Environmental Justice, and Children's Health and Safety
- Water Quality
- Wetlands
- Wild and Scenic Rivers

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Please accept this letter as our request for your agency review of known environmental concerns and potential impacts of the planned development. Please provide any comments, concerns, or requirements your agency may have regarding the listed impact categories no later than **September 5th, 2016.**
