Nevada 2014 Water Quality Integrated Report

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection is required by the Clean Water Act to conduct a comprehensive analysis of water quality data associated with Nevada's surface waters to determine whether state water quality standards are being met and designated uses are being supported. Nevada's Integrated Report is prepared in accordance with the requirements of Sections 303(d)/305(b)/314 of the Clean Water Act and is intended for use by the public, other entities and NDEP for water quality management planning purposes. The Nevada 2014 Integrated Report evaluates data collected over a 5 year period, between October 1, 2007 and September 30, 2012.

Nevada's 2014 Integrated Report was approved by U. S. Environmental Protection Agency on September 21, 2016 and included an over-listing of two waterbodies for Fish Tissue consumption due to mercury. These waters have been added to the list of impaired waters in Nevada's 2014 Integrated Report.
