RE: Alamo Sewer and Water General Improvement District (ASWGID) Improvements Project


Dear Mr. Canfield:

ASWGID is in the process of performing an environmental review pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act for the Nevada State Revolving Fund (SRF) in order that it may assess the environmental impacts of a water system improvements in Alamo, Nevada. The project includes the items listed below. Enclosed is a map that depicts the proposed project's area of potential effect for all construction activities.

1. A second production well up-gradient of the GID's arsenic compliant well – the Sandhill Well – the project will include an exploratory phase as well as development of the production well (104' x 104' = 0.25 ac.);
2. A water storage tank at, and providing service to the airport (147' x 147' = 0.50 ac.);
3. Installation of eight isolation valves (8' x 6' x 5' = 0.06 ac.);
4. work on the Purple Sage main including water service relocation/connection and abandonment of a 4-inch main (1,740' x 5' = 0.20 ac.);
5. Replacement of undersized 4-inch waterline south to Buckhorn Ranch Road and looping the waterline back to the system's arsenic compliant groundwater source on west side of the valley (15,903' x 5' = 1.83 ac.);
6. Installation of arsenic treatment for the Industrial Park Well (104' x 104' = 0.25 ac.) and;
7. Consolidation of transient systems including Windmill Ridge, JFDI Executive Retreat Ranch, Ash Springs, and Pahranaagat Wildlife Refuge (63,246' x 5' = 7.26 ac.) and;

Please distribute this information to any entity that might have an interest in the project. All responses and/or recommendations will be used to complete the SRF environmental assessment. 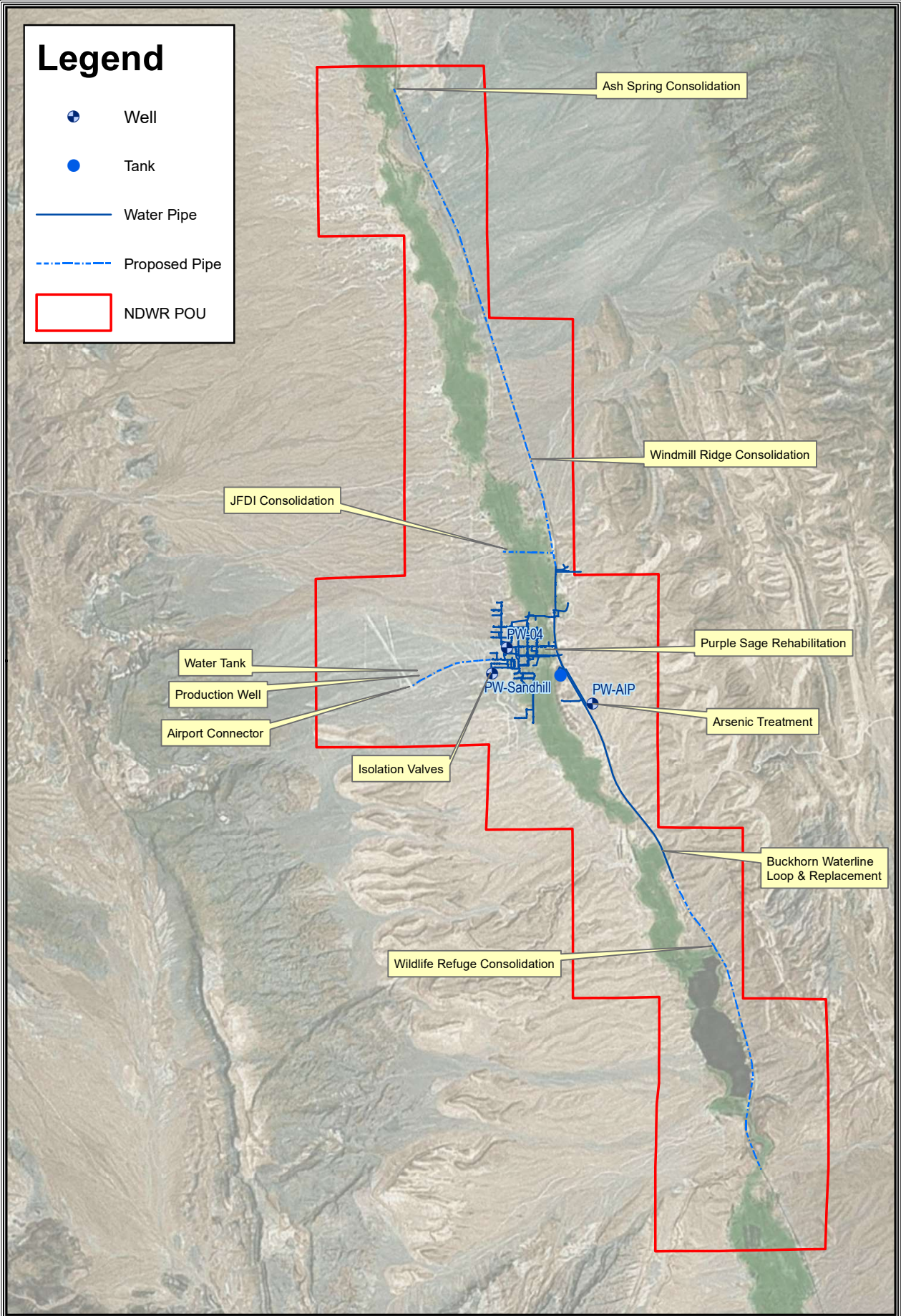

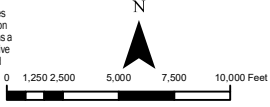
