The Project consists of an up to 1,600 MW power tower solar generation facility consisting of eight (8) solar towers with integrated molten salt storage, and associated power blocks, heliostat mirror fields, transmission interconnection lines, access roads, water pipelines and other such ancillary facilities as are typically associated with solar thermal generating facilities, on approximately 20,000 acres of public land in Nye County, Nevada.




