NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL APPROVAL
TO CONSTRUCT A UTILITY FACILITY

On September 4, 2020, EDF Renewables Development, Inc. (“EDF Renewables Development”) filed with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (“Commission”) a notice, designated as Docket No. 20-09005 (“Notice”), under the provisions of the Utility Environmental Protection Act, of an application to a federal agency for approval to construct the Playa del Sol Solar Project consisting of an up to 120 megawatt photovoltaic solar electric generating facility and associated facilities to be located in Clark County, Nevada.

This Notice serves only to notify the public that the Commission has received the above-referenced filing. It is the responsibility of interested persons to review the filing and monitor the proceedings to determine their desired levels of involvement based on how this matter may affect their unique situations. The details provided within this Notice are for informational purposes only and are not meant to be an all-inclusive overview of the filing.

EDF Renewables Development filed the Notice pursuant to the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”) Chapters 703 and 704, including, but not limited to, NRS 704.870(2) and NAC 703.421.
